FUTURE LEADERS GROUP - CLASS OF 2024


HISTORY & OBJECTIVE

The IIF Future Leaders Group was formed in 2014 by the IIF's Board of Directors to recognize emerging leaders within the financial industry and to foster ties between rising stars from different regions and backgrounds. Participants are nominated by their firms based on a track record of achievement within their institution and their potential, in the nominating institutions' view, to become a leader in global finance.

Participants attend two in-person programs during their year as an IIF Future Leader. In 2024, the Group will convene in Paris in May and again in Washington, DC in October. Each program is designed to introduce them to the big ideas and topics that will drive the future of the industry. The objective is to spur participants to think beyond their day-to-day responsibilities, engage on key issues they may confront as future industry leaders, and develop ties with other participants from different regions and backgrounds and create a new global network of colleagues. In addition to the lineup of exclusive Future Leader virtual town halls and webinars, Future Leaders are invited to attend other IIF regional and global events.

The Class of 2024 consists of 60 participants representing 58 institutions from different focus areas and professional levels. Positions range from research analysts, underwriters and policy advisors to managers, directors, vice presidents, and department and regional heads.
